RESEARCH GRANT 2019

The ISNK once again invites applicants to submit their research grant applications for 2019.

The maximum funding amount per individual project is **€ 20,000**.

Please submit your informal application together with the following documents **in English**:

1. Curriculum vitae (including education and description of research activities to date)
2. List of scientific publications to date
3. Subject of research project together with detailed project plan (including project goals, methodology, predicted outcomes, calculated cost for materials and personnel)
4. Information on the length of the research project and the period of time during which the grant would be used
5. Information on whether third-party funds are available or have been applied for
6. Declaration of the Head of Department/Institute confirming that the working facilities required for the successful completion of the project are available
7. Two references (not as letters of endorsement; just names of scientists who would be able to provide information on the applicant's education and scientific activity)

The submitted applications will be assessed by the jury appointed by the members of the Medical Advisory Board of the ISNK.

Applications must be submitted no later than **31 October 2018**, exclusively in electronic format and addressed to:
